Reading Problem Demonstration

Have parent read from bottom to top, move to the next column, then read down, up, down, to the end.

After 2 to 4 sentences of struggling, ask what the second or third sentence said.

For the most part, people will be unable to recall exactly what they just read.

Brief explanation: Tell them, "All that we've done is make it as difficult for you to read up and down as it is for your child to read across the page.

Then say, "that's what it's like for your child all day long at school! No wonder he/she's having such problems with reading and learning."
